**Kind Attention: Participating Institutes/ candidates for Round-2 of AACCC-PG Counseling for the A.Y. 2022-23**

The final result of Round 2 of AACCC-PG Counseling- 2022 has been uploaded on the AACCC-PG portal ([www.aaccc.gov.in](http://www.aaccc.gov.in)). Before proceeding for admission, candidates are instructed to download the “**Provisional Allotment Letter**” from the AACCC-PG portal. Further, it is requested to strictly adhere to the Counseling Schedule and admission rules as mentioned below:

<b>Approved Admission Rules for Round 2</b>	
<b>Conditions</b>	<b>Approved Rules</b>
Condition 1	Allotted/Upgraded candidates of R-2 who <b>wish to retain</b> their R-2 allotted/upgraded seat are <b>instructed to join</b> the institute within the stipulated time.
Condition 2	Allotted/Upgraded candidates of R-2 who <b>do not wish to retain their R-2 allotted/upgraded seat</b> are <b>instructed to avail free exit</b> within the stipulated time (no need to join the allotted institute).
Condition 3	Candidates whose seats have been <b>upgraded from R-1 to R-2 and wish to retain their R-2 allotted seats</b> are instructed to get an <b>online-generated Relieving letter</b> from the <b>previously joined institute of R-1 and report</b> to the allotted institute of R-2 <b>physically</b> within the stipulated time. ( <b>R- 1 joined seat will automatically be cancelled</b> )
Condition 4	Candidates whose seats have not been upgraded from R-1 to R-2 and do <b>not wish to retain</b> the R-1 joined seats are <b>instructed to avail free exit within five days after the announcement of Round 2 result</b> without forfeiture of security money (i.e. from <b>12:00 noon of 08.02.2023 to 05:00 PM of 12.02.2023</b> ). Further R-2 admission rules

	will be applicable on those candidates who withdraw their R-1 seat from 13.02.2023 to 22.02.2023.
Condition 5	If the candidates join the allotted/up-graded seat in the R- 2 and <b>do not wish to retain the joined seat</b> are instructed to exit three days prior to the commencement of the 3 <sup>rd</sup> /Mop-up Round (i.e. on or before 5:00 PM of <b>19.02.2023</b> ) <b>with forfeiture of security money</b> . Such candidates are allowed to participate in R-3 of AACCC-PG counseling by remitting fees & fresh choice filling on the AACCC-PG portal and are also eligible for participating in State/UTs-AYUSH PG Counseling.
Condition 6	R-2 admitted candidates who wish to upgrade their seats in R-3 are instructed to report to the allotted institute physically and <b>submit willingness for the upgradation</b> at the time of admission.
Condition 7	If any candidates withdraw/surrender their joined/admitted seats of R- 2 <b>after 19.02.2023</b> , such candidates will become <b>ineligible for further AYUSH-PG counseling (Central/State/UTs) and their security Money will be forfeited</b> .

#### IMPORTANT

- All candidates are advised to ensure that the admission process made by the allotted institute **through ONLINE MODE only by generating the “Provisional Admission Letter”** from the AACCC-PG portal. Any admission made through **OFFLINE MODE** shall be treated as null & void.
- Candidates are also advised to ensure that their seat “Surrender/Withdrawal Letters” are generated online through the AACCC-PG portal by the allotted institutes.
- All participating institutes are instructed to facilitate the admission/reporting of students even on holidays, if necessary.
