IMPORTANT NOTE

- Round-1/2 admitted candidates, willing to participate in State/UT Ayush Counseling/ to take admission on the seats allotted through State/UT Ayush Counseling MUST withdraw their seats allotted through AACCC-PG counseling via online mode from the admitted college on or before 05.11.2023. Otherwise, they will be Ineligible for further Ayush –PG Counseling (Central/State/UTs).
- All candidates are advised to ensure that admission process is made by the allotted college through online mode only by generating the "**Provisional Admission** Letter" from the AACCC PG portal. Any admission made through offline mode shall be treated as null & void.
- Candidates are also advised to ensure that their seat "Surrender/Withdrawal letters" are generated online through the AACCC-PG portal by the allotted institutes.
- All participating institutes are instructed to facilitate the admission/reporting of students even on holidays, if necessary.
