NOTICE

In continuation to previous notice dated 26.10.2023, keep in mind the following guidelines related to relieving/withdrawal/Surrender procedure.

Schedule/Procedure for Withdrawal/ Surrender facility for Round-1 admitted candidates

Institutes who withdrew/surrendered the seats of R-1 admitted candidates **through offline mode after 12:00 noon of 17.10.2023** are instructed to generate an online - withdrawal/surrender letter through the 'PI ADMIN ID' on the AACCC- PG portal from **3:00 PM of 26.10.2023 to 05:00 PM of 05.11.2023**.

Relieving Procedure for upgraded candidates of Round-1

- Round-1 upgraded candidates are advised to get the online - Relieving letter from the previous allotted Institutes and join the allotted institute of Round-2.
- Further the participating institutes are instructed to generate online - Relieving letter through the 'PI ADMIN ID' on the AACCC-PG portal for the candidates whose seats have been upgraded from R-1 to R-2.
- Furthermore, institutes can view the details of the upgraded candidates on the AACCC PG portal before generating the Relieving Letter.

Procedure for Relieving of Candidate willing to Quit from AACCC-PG Counseling

Candidates who are allotted seat through State Ayush Counseling/allotted MPH/MBA/MSc seat etc. reason and are willing to Quit from AACCC-PG Counseling then the Institutes must generate WITHDRAWAL/ SURRENDER LETTER, as mentioned above.

IMPORTANT

- AACCC, M/o Ayush, shall not approve admission/resignation/relieving (if allowed) made through offline mode.
- Further, institutes are instructed to send a copy of the online generated withdrawal/surrender letter to AACCC, M/o Ayush, via the E-mail counseling-ayush@gov.in without any failure.
