NOTICE

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR ROUND-3	
1.	Candidates who register for the first time.
2.	Registered candidates who have not been allotted any seat in Round 1 & Round 2.
3.	Round 1 allotted/admitted candidates availed of free exit within the stipulated period.
4.	Candidates whose seats have not been upgraded from R-1 to R-2 and availed free exit/withdrew (online) from R-1 joined seat within the stipulated time (from 26.10.2023 to 05:00 PM of 30.10.2023)
5.	R-1 admitted candidates who were not upgraded in Round-2.
6.	Candidates who submit willingness for up-gradation at the time of joining at Round 1 allotted Institute, but did not participate in the Round -2 of counseling
7.	Candidates admitted in Round 2 and submit willingness for up-gradation at the time of joining at Round 2 allotted Institute.
8.	Candidate allotted/upgraded a seat in the 2nd Round and not joined (availed free exit).
9.	Candidate withdraws (online) from the 2nd Round allotted seat, 3 days prior to commencement of the 3rd Round before 6:00 PM of 05.11.2023 , with forfeiture of Security Money (Need to submit the complete fees again).

NOTE:

- Candidates who have been allotted/upgraded seats in 3rd Round must take admission on their allotted/ upgraded seats. If candidates do not join the allotted/upgraded seats, their security money will be forfeited, and they will become ineligible for further AYUSH-PG counseling. (Central/State/UT).
- Candidate who hold any seat through State/UT Counseling, and would have also been allotted a seat during R-3 of AACCC-PG Counseling , in that case, the State/UT seat stands cancelled and he/she must join the R-3 allotted institute of AACCC-PG counseling.
