NOTICE

Withdrawal/Surrender facility for admitted candidates

- If a joined candidate of AACCC-UG/PG counseling gets allotted a seat through State Ayush Counseling/allotted MBBS/BDS/B.Sc seat etc or wants to withdraw the joined seat for any other reasons, in that case, the institutes are instructed to withdraw/surrendered the seats of admitted candidates through online mode and generate an **online withdrawal/surrender letter** through the 'PI ADMIN ID' on the AACCC-UG/PG portal.
- Further, kindly refer to the information bulletin, Counseling Scheme 2024 and FAQs uploaded on the website (https://intraaaccc.gov.in/#/home) to know about the forfeiture of the security money and ineligibility for further counseling owing to the withdrawal of the joined seat during different rounds of counseling.

Relieving Procedure for Upgraded Candidates

- If a candidate upgraded from previous rounds, then candidates need to get the **online Relieving**letter from the previously allotted Institutes to join the newly allotted institute.
- Further, the participating institutes are instructed to generate **online Relieving letter** through the 'PI ADMIN ID' on the AACCC-UG/PG portal for the candidates whose seats have been upgraded.
- Furthermore, institutes can view the details of the upgraded candidates on the AACCC-UG/PG portal before generating the Relieving Letter.

Cancellation of seats allotted through AACCC-UG Counseling

- If a candidate gets allotted seat through AACCC-UG/PG counseling as per the information provided by the candidates and later the candidate cannot produce the necessary documents during reporting at the allotted institute, in that case, admission of the candidate gets cancelled.
- Further, the participating institutes are instructed to generate **online Cancellation letter** through the '**PI USER ID**' on the AACCC-UG/PG portal.

IMPORTANT

- AACCC, M/o Ayush shall not approve admission/resignation/relieving (if allowed) made through offline mode.
- Further, institutes are instructed to send a copy of the online generated withdrawal/surrender/cancellation letter to AACCC, M/o Ayush, via the E-mail counseling-ayush@gov.in without any failure.
