**Kind Attention: Information on Physical Spot Round for PG (Ayurveda) seats under
AIIA, Goa for the A.Y 2024-25.**

In view of the permission issued to **All India Institute of Ayurveda, Goa (AIIA, Goa)** by NCISM on **05.11.2024**, (*copy enclosed*), the competent Authority of the Ministry has decided to conduct a **Physical Spot Round** for **10 AIQ-PG(Ayurveda)** seats from **29th November 2024 to 7th December 2024**. Candidates registered during Round 1, Round 2, Round 3, SVR-I and **SVR-DU (26.11.2024 to 28.11.2024)** of AACCC-PG counseling and have not secured their seats through Central/State/UT counseling are eligible to participate in the **Physical Spot Round** conducted by AIIA, Goa through AACCC-PG portal.

To become eligible to participate in the Physical Spot Round, candidates need to opt “**Central Universities/National Institutes**” as a **Selection of counseling** on the AACCC-PG portal. The **registration** and **registration unlocking** facility for the same is available on the portal during the schedule from **26.11.2024 to 28.11.2024**. (*The counseling Fee for participating in the Physical Spot Round; for Gen/EWS/OBC-NCL-22000/- and for SC/ST/PwD-21000/-*)

Eligibility for Participation

1. Newly qualified candidates after reduction of the **Minimum Qualifying Cut-Off Percentile** criteria for admission to ASU&H-PG courses for the A.Y 2024-25.
2. Candidates not registered on the AACCC-PG portal but have not secured any seat allotted through State/UT counseling 2024.
3. Candidates who have not been allotted any seats through Central/State/UT counseling for the A.Y 2024-25.
4. Candidates whose names have not been reflected in the ineligible candidate list published by AACCC-MoA on 21.11.2024 on the AACCC-PG portal.

Eligible registered Candidates who wish to participate in the Physical Spot Round (AIIA, Goa) are instructed to submit their *willingness cum undertaking* (*Annexure-I*) to the **institute** via e-mail ID (pgaiiagadmission@gmail.com) within the stipulated time schedule without any failure. Any request for submission of *willingness cum undertaking* **after the prescribed time** shall not be entertained by AACCC, M/o Ayush.

Reporting Rule

- If a candidate gets allotted seat in the Physical Spot Round, he/she **MUST JOIN**; otherwise, ineligible for further AYUSH-PG counseling (Central/State/UT) 2024 with forfeiture of Security Money.
- Further, if any candidate gets allotted a seat based on the *wrong information* that he/she is **not holding any seat**, in that case, his/her earlier (Central/State/UT) allotted/admitted seat and Physical spot Round allotted seat **will be cancelled** and become ineligible for further AYUSH-PG counseling (Central/State/UT) 2024 with forfeiture of Security Money.

Subject:- Grant of Letter of Permission to All India Institute of Ayurveda, North Goa, Dhargal, Pernem, Goa (AYU0806) to start 05 new Post Graduate courses with 20 seats (including EWS) in the subjects namely (i) Ayurveda Samhita & Siddhant-04 seats (including EWS) (ii) Kriya Sharir-04 seats (including EWS) (iii) Rachana Sharir-03 seats (including EWS) (iv) Agada Tantra-06 seats (including EWS) (v) Rasa Shastra and Bhaishajya Kalpana-03 seats (including EWS) from the academic session 2024-25 under section 29 of NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant regulations thereunder-reg.

Sir/Madam,

With reference to the subject mentioned above, I am directed to inform you that in pursuance of the provision of National commission for Indian System of Medicine Act, 2020, the Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970 (48 of 1970) has been repealed with effect from the 11th day of June, 2021. With effect from the said date, the Central Council of Indian Medicine constituted under sub-division (1) of section 3 of the Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970 (48 of 1970) shall stand dissolved. Now, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (3) of the section 1 of the said Act, the Central Government hereby notifies that all the provisions of the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine Act, 2020 has been come into force with effect from the 11th day of June, 2021 and as per regulation 59 (2) of The National Commission for Indian System of Medicine ACT, 2020, Medical standards, requirements and other provisions of the Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970 and the rules and regulations made there under shall continue to be in force and operate till new standards or requirements are specified under this Act or the rules and regulations made there under. Further, the provision of concerned regulations which are inconsistent with the provision of NCISM Act, 2020 shall not be applicable.

1. I am to refer to your application/scheme vide ref. no. **Z-25009/3/2024 AIIA GOA/168 dated 29.08.2024** on the subject cited above and to verify the available facilities of teaching, non-teaching, hospital staff and other facilities available at your college namely **All India Institute of Ayurveda, North Goa, Dhargal, Pernem, Goa (AYU0806) to start 05 new Post Graduate courses with 20 seats (including EWS) in the subjects namely (i) Ayurveda Samhita & Siddhant-04 seats (including EWS) (ii) Kriya Sharir-04 seats (including EWS) (iii) Rachana Sharir-03 seats (including EWS) (iv) Agada Tantra-06 seats (including EWS) (v) Rasa Shastra and Bhaishajya Kalpana-03 seats (including EWS)** visitation has been carried out for issuance of Letter of Intent (LOI) on **10.10.2024 & 11.10.2024 through hybrid mode** by the visitation team of Medical Assessment and Rating Board (NCISM) and Letter of Intent (LOI) has been issued to your college vide letter of **even no. dated 18.10.2024 under section 29 of NCISM Act 2020 from the academic session 2024-25.**
2. The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM) had carried out an inspection of the college again on **28.10.2024 & 29.10.2024 through hybrid mode** to assess the available facilities of teaching, non-teaching, Hospital staff, practical training and other infrastructure **for issuance of Letter of Permission to start 05 new Post Graduate courses with 20 seats (including EWS) in the subjects namely (i) Ayurveda Samhita & Siddhant-04 seats (including EWS) (ii) Kriya Sharir-04 seats (including EWS) (iii) Rachana Sharir-03 seats (including EWS) (iv) Agada Tantra-06 seats (including EWS) (v) Rasa Shastra and Bhaishajya Kalpana-03 seats (including EWS) from the academic session 2024-25 under section 29 of NCISM Act 2020.**

3. Further, the visitation report and all other related documents were assessed in terms of the enforced regulations namely, the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016", the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Post-graduate Ayurveda Education) Regulations, 2016", provisions under the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant Regulations there under. On careful examination of the assessment report, it was found that **your college is not fulfilling the notified & approved criteria due to the following short comings.**
 - a) Animal house is not available.
 - b) Central Research laboratory is not available.
 - c) Total no. of beds available are 20 and there is a shortcoming of 80 beds.
4. Hence, it has been decided to ask for clarification regarding the above mentioned shortcomings and same was communicated to the college vide an email dated **04.11.2024. In response of the same, you have submitted the asked documents via email dated 04.11.2024.**
5. Further, it has been decided to issue **Letter of Permission to start 05 new Post Graduate courses with 20 seats (including EWS) in the subjects namely (i) Ayurveda Samhita & Siddhant-04 seats (including EWS), (ii) Kriya Sharir-04 seats (including EWS) (iii) Rachana Sharir-03 seats (including EWS) (iv) Agada Tantra-06 seats (including EWS) (v) Rasa Shastra and Bhaishajya Kalpana-03 seats (including EWS) under Section 29 of NCISM Act, 2020 from the academic session 2024-25 and same was approved subject to ratification in the ensuing Board meeting of Medical Assessment and Rating Board, NCISM.**
6. Therefore, **Letter of Permission is issued to All India Institute of Ayurveda, North Goa, Dhargal, Pernem, Goa (AYU0806) to start 05 new Post Graduate courses with 20 seats (including EWS) in the subjects namely (i) Ayurveda Samhita & Siddhant-04 seats (including EWS) (ii) Kriya Sharir-04 seats (including EWS) (iii) Rachana Sharir-03 seats (including EWS) (iv) Agada Tantra-06 seats (including EWS) (v) Rasa Shastra and Bhaishajya Kalpana-03 seats (including EWS) from the academic session 2024-25 under section 29 of NCISM Act 2020 and relevant regulations thereunder, subject to following conditions-**
 - I. It is further informed that minimum **50% of postgraduate seats of the permitted intake capacity with 20 seats (including EWS)** shall be treated as All India Quota. The counseling for seats under all India quota shall be conducted by respective counseling authority as designated by Central Government for A.Y. 2024-25 and counseling for the remaining 50% seats or as the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned Counseling Authority of that State/UT. **The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the aforesaid direction of the Central Government/NCISM for all India quota or the students admitted thereunder.**
7. Admissions made in violation of the above conditions will be treated as invalid and action will be initiated under NCISM Act & Regulations thereunder.
8. Further, **as per Sub-section (7) of Section 29 of NCISM Act, 2020**, The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine may conduct evaluation and assessment of any University or medical institution at any time, either directly or through any other expert, having integrity and experience in medical profession, without any prior notice and assess and evaluate the performance, standards and benchmarks of such University or medical institution and if the college is found to be not maintaining the Minimum Essential standards as specified in the concerned Acts & Regulations then **in accordance of Section 28 (1) (f) of NCISM Act, 2020 the issued permission of the college shall deemed to be withdrawn and denial of permission shall be issued by MARBISM for stoppage of admission for that particular or the subsequent academic year**
9. Discrepancies, if any, may be immediately brought to the notice of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine, NCISM.
10. **The following requirements should be fulfilled by the college by 31st December, 2024 and submit a compliance report to be considered for the grant of permission for the academic session 2025-26: -**
 - i) All the requirements under the provisions of the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant Regulations made thereunder should be fulfilled in toto.
 - ii) All the requirements of Minimum Standard of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in NCISM (Minimum essential standards, assessment and rating for undergraduate Ayurveda colleges and attached teaching hospitals) Regulations, 2024.

- iii) All the requirements of the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine (Minimum Standards of Undergraduate Ayurveda Education) Regulations-2022.
- iv) All the requirements of Minimum Essential Standards, Assessment and Rating for Postgraduate Institutions Minimum Standards for Postgraduate Education in Ayurveda Regulations, 2024.
- v) The shortcomings mentioned in point no 3 above should be fulfilled.
11. This permission to start 05 new PG course with 20 seats (including EWS) from the academic session 2024-25 as stated above for the first admitted batch of 2024-25 session, will be valid till such time as the first batch of students admitted against these courses appear for the first final examination of the said courses and at that time, the College authorities may take up the matter for recognition of the qualifications under Section 35 of the NCISM Act 2020.
12. The fulfillment of the conditions given above may be made within the time period specified and compliance report should be submitted by the college to President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine. The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine will verify that the conditions have been fulfilled for considering the permission for the academic session 2025-26.
13. The issued letter of Permission is subject to ratification in the ensuing Board Meeting.
