	Candidates <b>do not wish to join</b> the allotted institute	<b>If not join, Free Exit</b> available. Can participate in subsequent rounds as per the eligibility fixed for that round by filling fresh choices.
	Candidates <b>wish to resign from the joined R-1 seat.</b>	<b>Can avail of Free exit</b> till the date of announcement of the R-2 final result ( <i>excluding final result date</i> ) and can participate in subsequent rounds as per the eligibility fixed for that round by filling fresh choices.

		<p><b>Can avail exit with forfeiture</b> from the date of announcement of R-2 final result till 3 days prior to the commencement of Round 3 so that can participate in subsequent rounds as per the eligibility fixed for that round by paying complete fees again and filling fresh choices.</p> <p>R-1 admitted candidates who withdraw their seats with forfeiture between 3 days prior to the commencement of Round 3 and till the date of publication of the 3<sup>rd</sup> Round final result (excluding the final result date), will become <b>ineligible for AACCC-PG counseling.</b></p> <p>R-1 admitted candidates who withdraw their seats with forfeiture from the date announcement of the 3<sup>rd</sup> Round final result will be <b>ineligible for further Ayush-PG counseling. (Central/State/UT)</b></p>
<b>If not allotted</b>	Wish to participate in the next rounds of AACCC-PG counseling	Candidates can participate in subsequent rounds as per the eligibility fixed for that round by filling fresh choices.

- All candidates are advised to ensure that admission process made by the allotted college only through online mode by generating the **“Provisional Admission Letter”** from the AACCC PG portal. Any **admission made through offline mode shall be treated as null and void.**
