If a college does not provide the data on vacant seat status, in time, such college will not be considered for the Stray Vacancy Round and the seats of those colleges will remain vacant without allotment for the A.Y 2022-23. Furthermore, any request in this regard shall not be entertained by AACCC, M/o Ayush.
