With reference to the subject cited above, I am directed to inform that for completing the precounseling process of the AACCC-UG counseling for the academic year 2023-24; the participating colleges/institutes need to update their Institute profile and seat matrix on the AACCC-UG portal (www.aaccc.gov.in)

- 2. The AACCC, M/o Ayush will send the URL, Login ID, and Password to the colleges/institutes to update the Institute profile and Seat matrix on the AACCC-UG portal through counseling email (counseling-ayush@gov.in) in order of permission issued by NCISM/NCH. The Institutes are requested to keep Login ID and Password details confidential and should not share the same with anyone.
- 3. Participating Institutes are requested to update/modify the correct factual information related to the college if any, including (i) Category of college, i.e. Government/Government aided/National Institute /Deemed University/ Central University, (ii) name of the State, where colleges are located or any other related information (iii) Name of the ASU&H course/s (iv) availability of the hostel, its accommodation capacity, mess, etc. relevant details (v) Name of the Principal,etc,and (vi) admission fee refund policy/guidelines. The College authority shall immediately inform the Ministry by sending an E-mail on counseling-ayush@gov.in or may contact on Ministry's landline No. **011-24651980**.
- 4. Further, for reference, Comprehensive guidelines for AACCC-UG counseling-2023 and admission in ASU&H undergraduate courses are annexed herewith. All participating institutes are requested to strictly adhere to the directives in respect of the counseling and admission process issued by AACCC, M/o Ayush/NCISM/NCH from time to time for smooth conduction of the counseling process for the A.Y 2023-24.

COMPREHENSIVE GUIDELINES FOR AACCC-UG COUNSELING AND ADMISSION IN UNDERGRADUATE (UG-BAMS/BSMS/BUMS/BHMS) COURSES OF AYURVEDA, SIDDHA, UNANI& HOMOEOPATHY (ASU&H) STREAMS FOR THE ACADEMIC SESSION 2023-2024

- 1. Ayush Admissions Central Counseling Committee (AACCC), Ministry of Ayush will conduct "AIQ-UG Online Counseling" for admission in Govt. / Govt. Aided Colleges/Institutes, Central/Deemed Universities(government and private-established under Central Act), and National Institutes of ASU&H streams.
- 2. Qualification Criterion for admission to ASU&H-UG Courses: (As per the ASU&H-UG & PG Regulations in force at the time of admission)

Passing marks for eligibility in admission to ASU&H-UG courses should be as per the ASU&H-UG regulations and should be followed strictly. The details qualifications for different categories are as follows:

- i. (a) <u>For ASU- UG Courses</u> Candidate must have obtained a minimum of 50% marks taken together in Physics, Chemistry and Biology at the 10+2 or equivalent examination in the case of general category and 40% Marks in the case of the Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes, and Other Backward Classes.
- (b) <u>For Homeopathy-UG Course</u> Candidate must have obtained a minimum of 50% marks taken together in Physics, Chemistry and Biology/Biotechnology at the 10+2 or equivalent examination in the case of general category and 40% Marks in the case of the Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes, and Other Backward Classes.
- ii. In respect of persons with disability as specified under the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016 (49 of 2016), the minimum qualifying marks in the said qualifying examination as follows: a) shall be 45% in the case of the general category. b) 40% in the case of the Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and Other Backward Classes.
- iii. No candidate shall be admitted to BAMS, BSMS, BUMS& BHMS Degree Courses unless he/she has attained the age of seventeen years on or before the 31st December of the year of his/her admission in the first year of the course. Further, there is no upper age limit for admission to ASU&H-UG courses.
- iv. In order to be eligible for admission to an undergraduate course for an academic year, it shall be necessary for a candidate to obtain minimum of marks at 50th percentile in the 'National Eligibility Entrance Test for the undergraduate course' held for the said academic year: Provided that in respect of-
 - (A) candidates belonging to the Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and Other Backward Classes, the minimum marks shall be at the 40th percentile;
 - (B) candidates with benchmark disabilities specified under the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016 (49 of 2016), the minimum marks shall be at 45th percentile in the case of the General category and 40th percentile in the case of the Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and Other Backward Classes.

- 3. The colleges are requested to follow the instructions before updating the seat matrix as below
 - a) Ensure the number of Total seats, AIQ seats, and State quota seats as per the permission letter issued by NCISM/NCH for the academic year 2023-24 and also in consultation with the respective State/UT counseling Authorities.
 - b) AIQ-UG seats may be calculated as follows-

In the case of Govt./Govt. Aided colleges, 15% of the total permitted intake capacity of UG courses shall be treated as AIQ seats. If the percentage of permitted intake capacity comes in decimal, then it shall be counted as below-

- ➤ If the decimal comes below 0.50, it will be considered as the nearest next lower digit. If it comes equal to or exceeds 0.50, it will be considered as the nearest next upper digit.
 - For example: if the total permitted intake capacity of the UG course of a college is 30, then the 15% of AIQ for the same is 4.5, and it may be treated as 05. If the total permitted intake capacity of the UG course of the college is 35, then the 15% of AIQ for the same is 5.25, and it may be treated as 05.
- 4. The colleges should follow the AACCC-UG counseling schedule uploaded on the AACCC portal. It is further instructed to facilitate the admission/reporting of students allotted seats during the 1st/2nd/3rd Round and Stray Vacancy Round, even on Sundays and holidays, if necessary.
- 5. It is strictly instructed that all admissions be made online only; the AACCC, M/o Ayush will not consider offline admissions in any circumstances.
- 6. All admissions and resignations (if allowed) will be made through online mode only; no offline admissions/resignation of the seat is permitted.
- 7. Admission made in violation of the Central Government / NCISM / NCH directives will be treated as invalid, and action will be initiated under NCISM Act, 2020 / NCH Act, 2020.
- 8. ASU&H colleges/institutes should ensure the eligibility of the candidate as laid down in respective NCISM (MSE-UG) Regulations 2022 for Ayurveda, Siddha & Unani for admissions in ASU-UGcourses and NCH (Homoeopathy Graduate Degree Course Bachelor of Homoeopathic Medicine and Surgery (B.H.M.S). Regulations- 2022, for admissions in Homoeopathy-UG courses by proper scrutiny of the relevant certificates and documents at the time of admission.
- ASU&H colleges/institutes should ensure the authenticity and correctness of the details of admitted students before completing admission procedures. No modifications/ corrections after the cut-off date and time of admission as specified by NCISM/NCH shall be entertained.
- 10. Institutes will be held responsible if students face hardship due to admission irregularities (offline admissions, admission without counseling, and admission beyond sanctioned intake capacity). In such cases, students shall be discharged from the course and institution, and the institute will be subjected to face consequences as per the provision laid down under the sub-

- section (1)(a)(f) of section 28; sub-section (3) of section 10 of NCISM Act 2020/NCH Act, and the persons responsible will be prosecuted as per the section of IPC concerned.
- 11. ASU & H colleges/ institutes should ensure that no extra fees will be charged from the candidate other than fee details (admission fees, hostel, and mess fees) mentioned in the institute profile uploaded on the AACCC-UG portal.
- 12. ASU & H colleges/ institutes should ensure that no fees (submitted at the time of admission by the candidate) will be deducted by the college on re-allocation/upgradation of a seat from 1st Round to 2nd/3rd Round or 2nd Round to 3rd Round of AACCC-UG Counseling.
- 13. College authority shall inform the Ministry via E-mail ID (counseling-ayush@gov.in) regarding any specific provision for seat allotment, such as college only for girls, etc.
- 14. It is requested that all participating institutes must visit the AACCC-UG portal (www.aaccc.gov.in) from time to time for the AACCC-UG counseling scheme & FAQs, Schedule, and any updates/notices regarding UG counseling 2023-24.
- 15. State/UT Counseling Authorities have to conduct counseling for admission in UG-BAMS/BSMS/BUMS/BHMS Courses of ASU&H colleges/institutes /Private State Universities (other than Deemed Universities) in adherence with guidelines /schedule provided by the AACCC, Ministry of Ayush/NCISM/NCH to avoid the overlapping of the Schedule of AACCC-UG counseling and State/UT-UG counseling.
