Approved Admission Rules for Stray Vacancy Round (SVR-II)		
Condition I	Candidates who have been allotted seats during Stray Vacancy Round-II (SVR-II)	MUST join the allotted seat as per schedule; otherwise, ineligible for Central/State/UT Ayush-UG Counseling 2024 with forfeiture of security money.
Condition II	If a Candidate has been allotted a seat through SVR-II of AACCC-UG Counseling by submitting the wrong undertaking on the portal stating that, <i>‘he/she is not holding any seat through Central/State/UT Counseling rounds’</i> .	In that case, the candidate MUST join the course/college allotted through AACCC-UG Counseling as per schedule. The seat holding by the candidates, allotted through any State/UT-Ayush Counseling rounds, if any, shall stand cancelled.

NOTE

- All candidates are advised to ensure that admission process made by the allotted college through **ONLINE MODE** only by generating the “**Provisional Admission Letter**” from the AACCC UG portal. **Any admission made through offline mode shall be treated as null & void.**
- Candidates are informed that there is **NO PROVISION FOR SURRENDER / WITHDRAWAL** of the seat allotted through the Stray Vacancy Round (SVR-II)
- All participating institutes are instructed to facilitate the admission/reporting of students even on holidays, if necessary.
