of AACCC-UG Counseling for the A.Y. 2024-25**

**Salient Features of Special Stray Vacancy Round (SSVR) for All India  
Quota seats under Govt./Govt. Aided/CU/NI/ B. Pharm (Ay)-ITRA,  
Jamnagar**

In view of the reduction of the minimum qualifying cut-off percentile for admission to ASU&H-UG courses for the A.Y 2024-25, it has been decided to conduct a Special Stray Vacancy Round for vacant seats under Govt./Govt. Aided/ CU/NI/B. Pharm (Ay) seats after the Stray Vacancy Round (SVR-II). (*Schedule for SSVR is uploaded in the portal*)

- Registration & Choice filling available in SSVR
- No upgradation available in SSVR from previous rounds
- Only vacant seats after SVR-II and withdrawn seats are included in the SSVR (available on the AACCC-UG portal as per schedule)
- The seats permitted by NCISM/NCH after the freezing of the seat matrix for R-3 of AACCC-UG counseling are not included in the SSVR.
- The allotment will be purely based on the choices locked by the candidates/locked as per server time during the choice-filling period for SSVR.

**Eligibility for Participation**

1. Newly qualified candidates after reduction of the **Minimum Qualifying Cut-Off Percentile** criteria for admission to ASU&H-UG courses for the A.Y 2024-25.
2. Candidates not registered on the AACCC-UG portal but have not secured any seat allotted through State/UT counseling
3. Candidates who have not been allotted any seats through Central/State/UT counseling for the A.Y 2024-25.
4. Candidates whose name has not been reflected in the ineligible list published by AACCC-MoA on 12.11.2024 on the AACCC-UG portal.

Approved admission/Reporting Rule for SSVR		
Condition I	Candidates who have been allotted seats during the Stray Vacancy Round (SVR-II)	<b>MUST</b> join the allotted seat as per schedule; otherwise, ineligible for any Ayush-PG Counseling 2024 (Central/State-UT) with forfeiture of counseling fees.
Condition II	If a Candidate has been allotted a seat through SVR-II of AACCC-PG Counseling by submitting the wrong undertaking on the portal stating that, ' <i>he/she is not holding any seat through Central /State/UT Counseling rounds</i> '.	In that case, the candidate <b>MUST</b> join the course/college allotted through AACCC-PG Counseling as per schedule. The seat holding by the candidates, allotted through any State/UT Counseling rounds, if any, shall stand cancelled.
If a candidate gets allotted seat in SSVR, based on the wrong undertaking that <i>I am not holding any seats</i> , in that case, his/her earlier allotted /admitted seat through Central/State/UT counseling and seat allotted in the SSVR stands shall be cancelled.		

**Note:** Eligible candidates who wish to participate in SSVR need to make a calculative decision before participating, as once they are allotted a seat in SSVR of AACCC-UG Counseling 2024, they **MUST** join the SSVR allotted institute and their admitted seat/earlier allotted/ seat allotted after SSVR result through any rounds of State/UT-Ayush UG Counseling 2024, if any, shall stand cancelled.

### Salient Features of Stray Vacancy Round (SVR-DU) for Deemed Universities

- No separate Registration Facility is available for candidates who are seeking admission to Deemed Universities.
- Registration is common for all Govt./ Gov.-aided/CU/NI/Deemed Institutes. (schedule 25.11.2024 to 27.11.2024)
- Registered candidates who opted for '**Deemed University**' as '**selection of counseling**' on the AACCC-UG portal during **R-1, R-2, R-3, SVR-I and SSVR** and not holding any seats allotted during any rounds of AACCC- UG/State/UT counseling may participate in SVR-DU.
- Non-registered candidates/newly qualified candidates after percentile reduction who wish to participate in SVR-DU are advised to register themselves on the AACCC portal during the SSVR as per schedule.
- AACCC, MoA will send vacant seat data and eligible/ineligible candidates list to the Deemed Universities to conduct SVR-DU through the AACCC-UG portal.

- Candidates who have not opted for '**Deemed University**' as '**selection of counseling**' on the AACCC-UG portal during R-1, R-2, R-3, SVR-I and SSVR are not eligible for admission to Deemed Universities through SVR-DU of AACCC-UG counseling 2024
- If a candidate gets admitted at Deemed Universities through SVR-DU, he/she will not be allowed to withdraw/surrender the admitted seat.
