NOTICE

Withdrawal/ Surrender facility for admitted candidates

- If a candidate who has joined a seat through AACCC-UG/PG counseling is subsequently allotted a seat through State AYUSH Counseling, or allotted an MBBS/BDS/B.Sc. seat, or wishes to withdraw from the joined seat for any other reason, the respective institute is required to process the withdrawal/surrender of the candidate's seat online. The institute must generate the **online withdrawal/surrender** letter using the '**PI ADMIN ID**' on the AACCC-UG/PG portal.
- For further details regarding the forfeiture of security money and ineligibility for subsequent rounds of counseling due to withdrawal from a joined seat in various counseling rounds, please refer to the Information Bulletin, Counseling Scheme 2025, and FAQs available on the official website.

Relieving Procedure for Upgraded Candidates

- If a candidate upgraded from previous rounds, then candidates need to get the **online - Relieving letter** from the previously allotted Institutes to join the newly allotted institute.
- Further, the participating institutes are instructed to generate **online - Relieving letter** through the '**PI ADMIN ID**' on the AACCC-UG/PG portal for the candidates whose seats have been upgraded.
- Furthermore, institutes can view the details of the upgraded candidates on the AACCC-UG/PG portal before generating the Relieving Letter.

Cancellation of seats allotted through AACCC-UG Counseling

- If a candidate gets allotted seat through AACCC-UG/PG counseling as per the information provided by the candidates and later the candidate cannot produce the necessary documents during reporting at the allotted institute, in that case, admission of the candidate gets cancelled.
- Further, the participating institutes are instructed to generate **online - Cancellation letter** through the '**PI USER ID**' on the AACCC-UG/PG portal.

IMPORTANT

- AACCC, NCISM/NCH shall not approve admission/resignation/relieving (if allowed) made through offline mode.
- Further, institutes are instructed to send a copy of the online generated withdrawal/surrender/cancellation letter to AACCC via the E-mail counseling-ayush@gov.in without any failure.
